## **Ops Outlet: National intensive enforcement** on illegal cigarettes



Recent statistics from the Operasi Outlet campaign (2 January to 7 Oct):

- No. of outlets raided = 4,679
- No. of retailers arrested = 1,127
- No. of retailers charged in court = **800**
- Total illegal cigarettes seized = **229 million sticks**

Customs cracking down on illegal cigarette sales

OHOR BARU: A worker at a sundry shop tried to hide illegal cigarettes under a chicken coop during a night raid by Customs officers but to no

## Regular ops to stub out illegal ciggies

## 'Move timely as sales have become widespread'

RUALA LUMPUR: Ops Punturg, a joint operation to combat the possession and sale of illegal cigarettes, will be made a regular activity by the authorities, says the Health Ministry.

Deputy director-general of health (public health) Datuk Dr Lokman Hakim Sulaiman said the move was timely as the sale of illegal cigarettes has become widespread in the country and it should be stopped.

"Apart from committing the offence of not paying taxes (on the cigarettes), the widespread use of contraband cigarettes also undermines the Government's efforts to discourage smoking by making cigarettes more expensive." he said yesterday after taking part in the inaugural Ops Pantung operation at Pudu Sentral here yesterday.

The joint operation was carried

out by enforcement officers from the Health Ministry, the Customs Department, the Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Ministry and the police.

Dr Lokman said 46 compound notices totalling RM12,250 in fines were issued during yesterday's operation.

Forty-three notices were issued to people who were caught smoking in designated smoke-free areas, while three notices were issued to traders and customers for selling or buying contraband cigarettes.

Customs deputy director (prevention and seizures) Abdul Wahabi Abdullah, who was also present, said that 6,192 sticks of contraband cigarettes, worth RM538.76, were seized during the operation.

The amount of unpaid taxes came to RM3,112.04.

He added that Customs officers also detained five people for selling contraband cigarettes.


## Illegal cigarettes incidence down 3.1ppts due to robust enforcement





## Aspirational Premium continues to grow at the expense of Premium























### **Q3 Discrete: Key Metrics**












### **Q3 YTD: Volume and Revenue**












## **Q3 YTD: Key Metrics**








