

- BAT view minimum requirement is differential tax between GST and SST
- MOH interpretation has not been formalized.
- Awaiting for guidance from MOH on SST interpretation

New Government's manifesto: Promise 52 – Fight crime and social ill "Enforcement agencies will be directed to stop smuggling of alcohol and cigarettes across the border, including tighter controls along the borders and heavier punishments to those who convicted"

Positive progress by the enforcement agencies

Enforcement actions

- 378 individual arrested (23 suspects arrested by Police, 355 suspects arrested by RMC)
- RM 23 million worth of seizure (RM 9 mn by Police, RM 14 mn by RMC)

Heavier punishments

RMC reiterated minimum RM 100K + whipping for selling of illegal cigarettes




